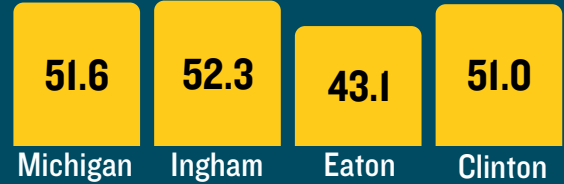
EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT

70% of jobs in Mid-Michigan will require education beyond high school by 2025.

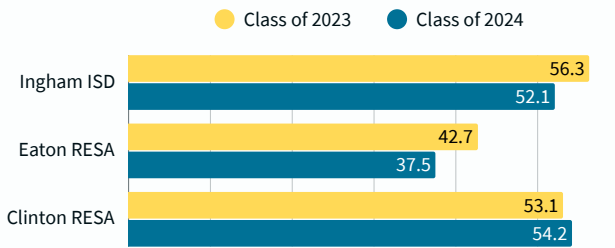
Percentage of adults ages 25-64 who have a post-secondary degree or credential (2023)

GOAL 1: COLLEGE ENROLLMENT

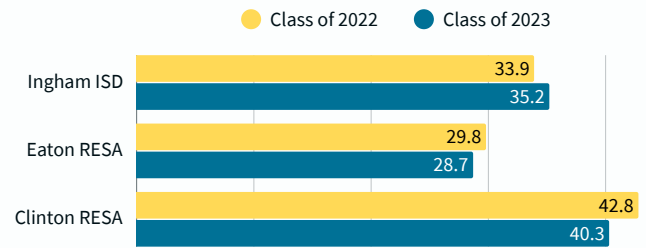
Increase the percentage of students who enroll in post-secondary education within 6 months

GOAL 2: COLLEGE PERSISTENCE

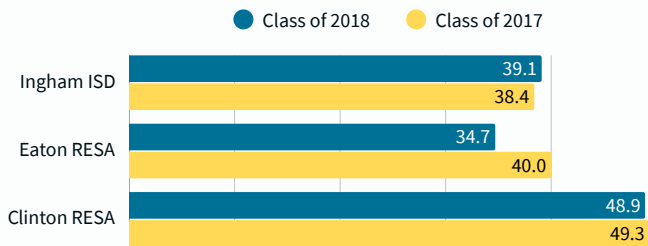
Increase the percentage of students enrolled in college who persist towards degree completion.

Increase the percentage of high school graduates who complete a postsecondary certificate or degree within 6 years.

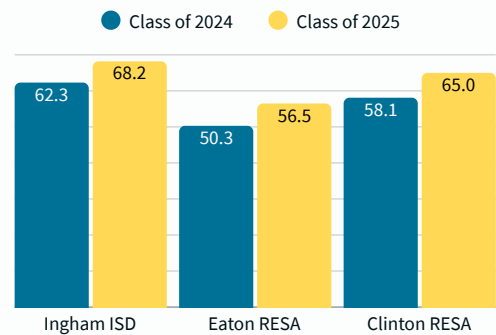

FAFSA Completion

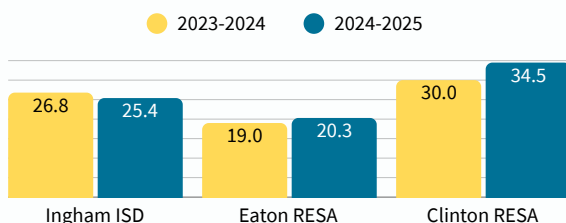
